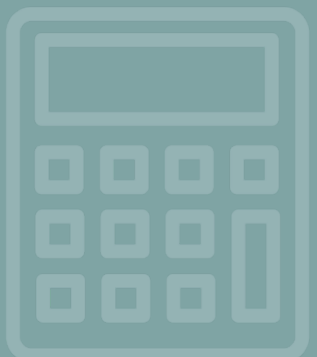
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foundational principle

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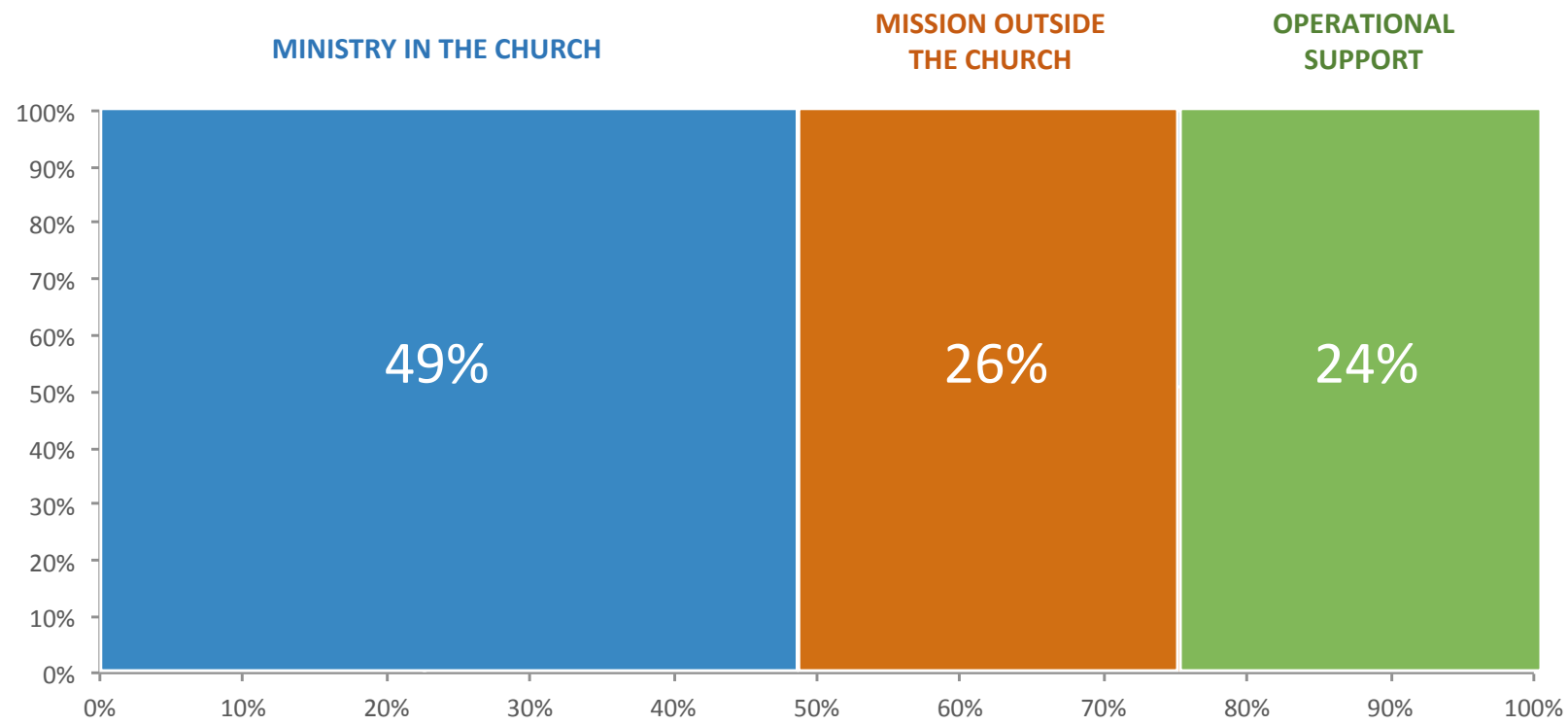

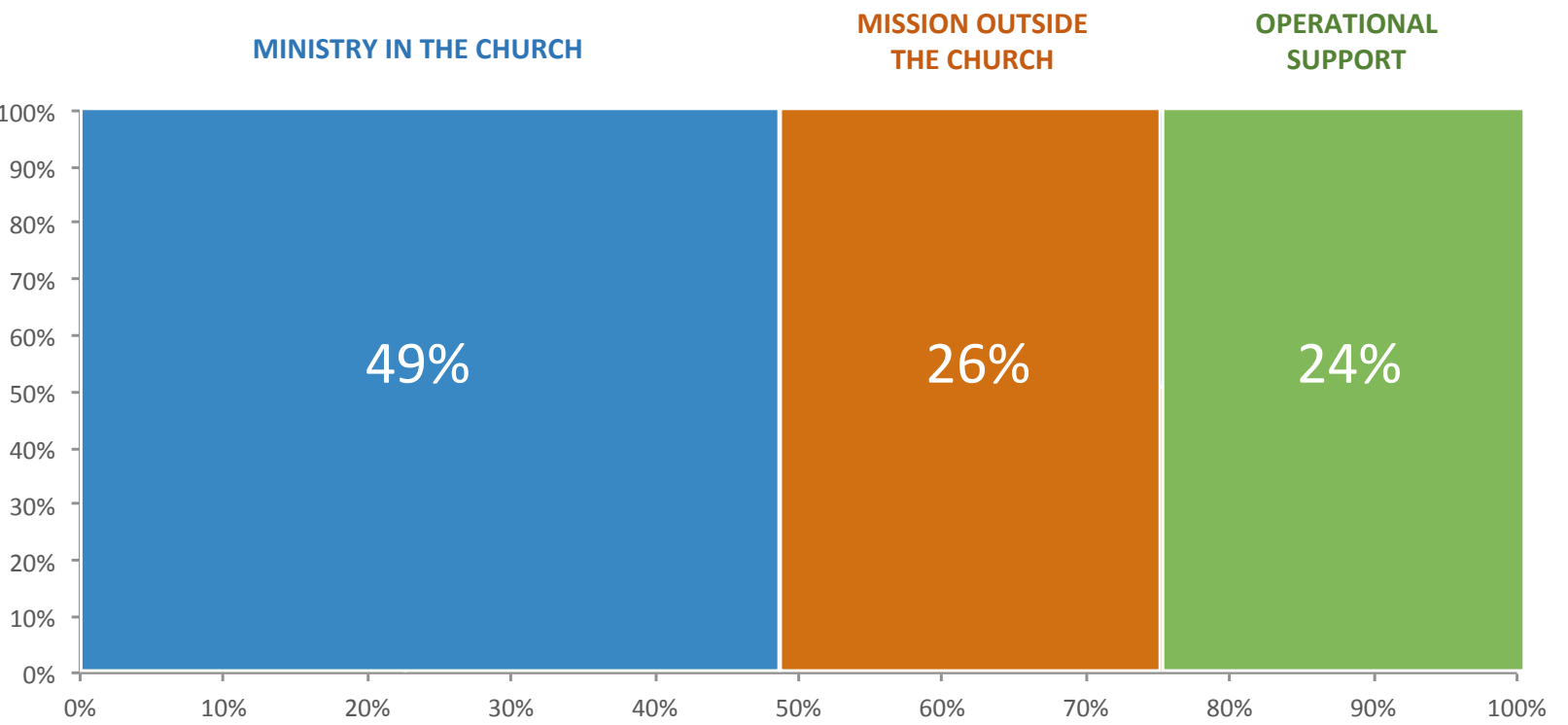
Our church spending can be broken down into 3 segments.

Breakdown of actual expenses (YTD, 7 months to April 2018)



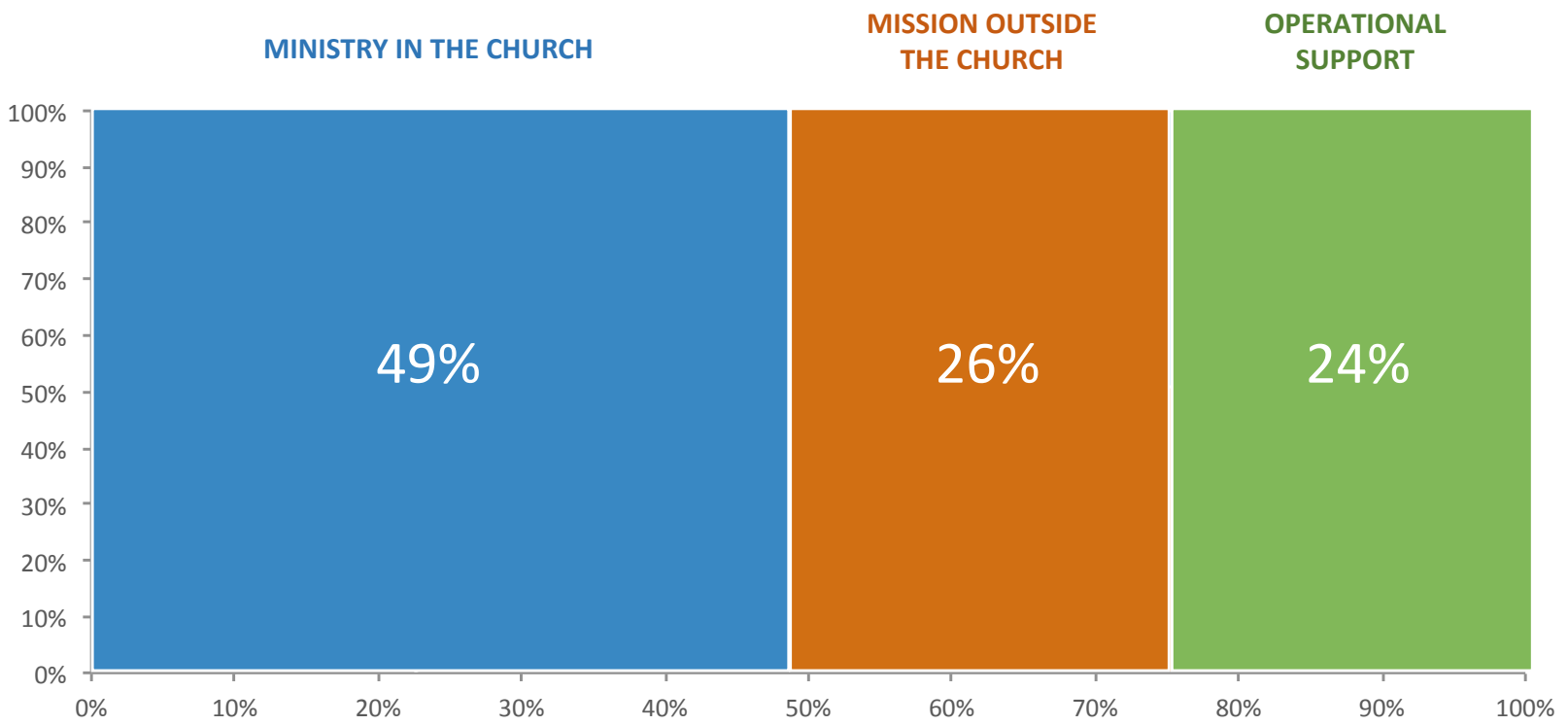
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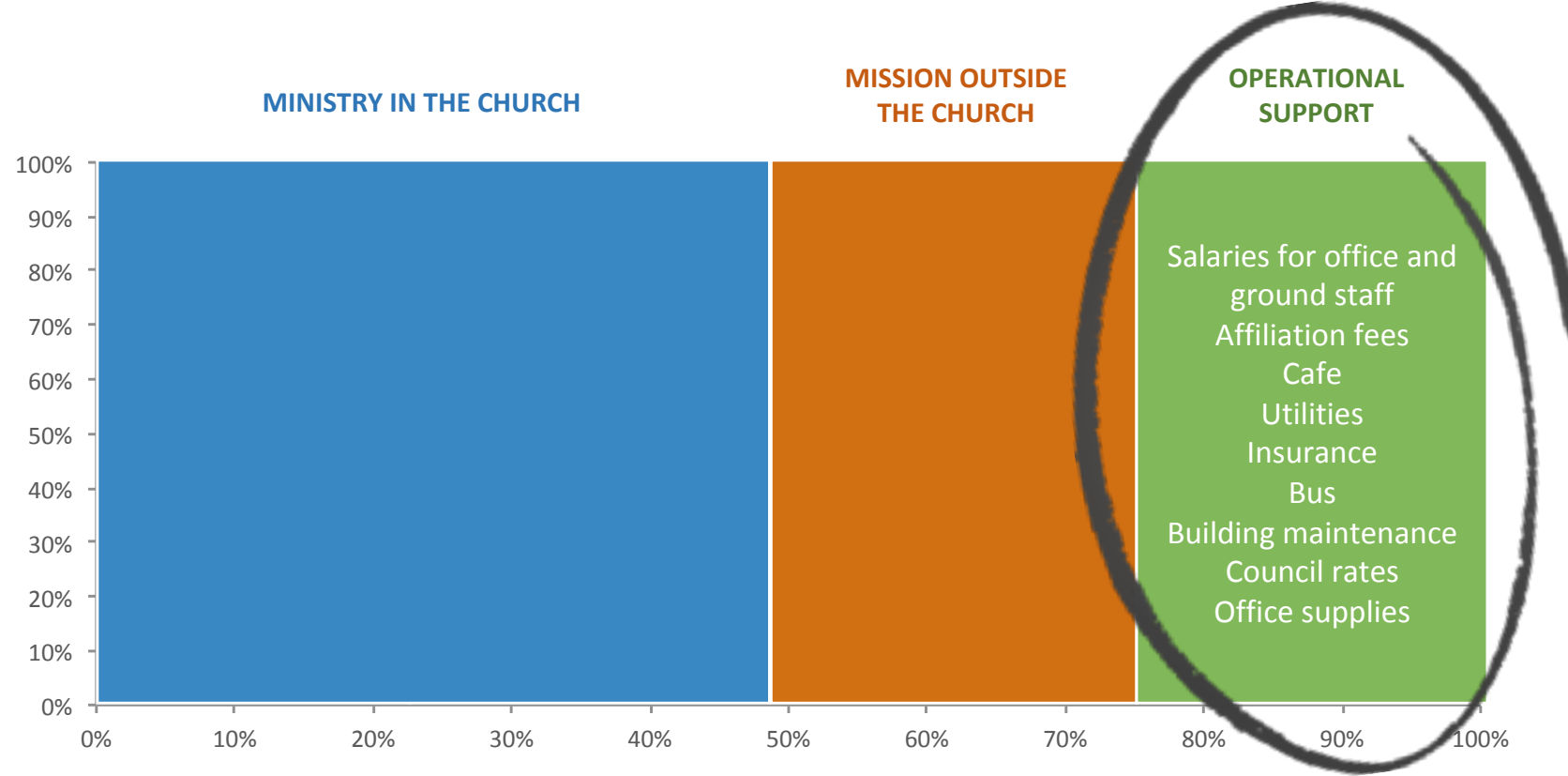


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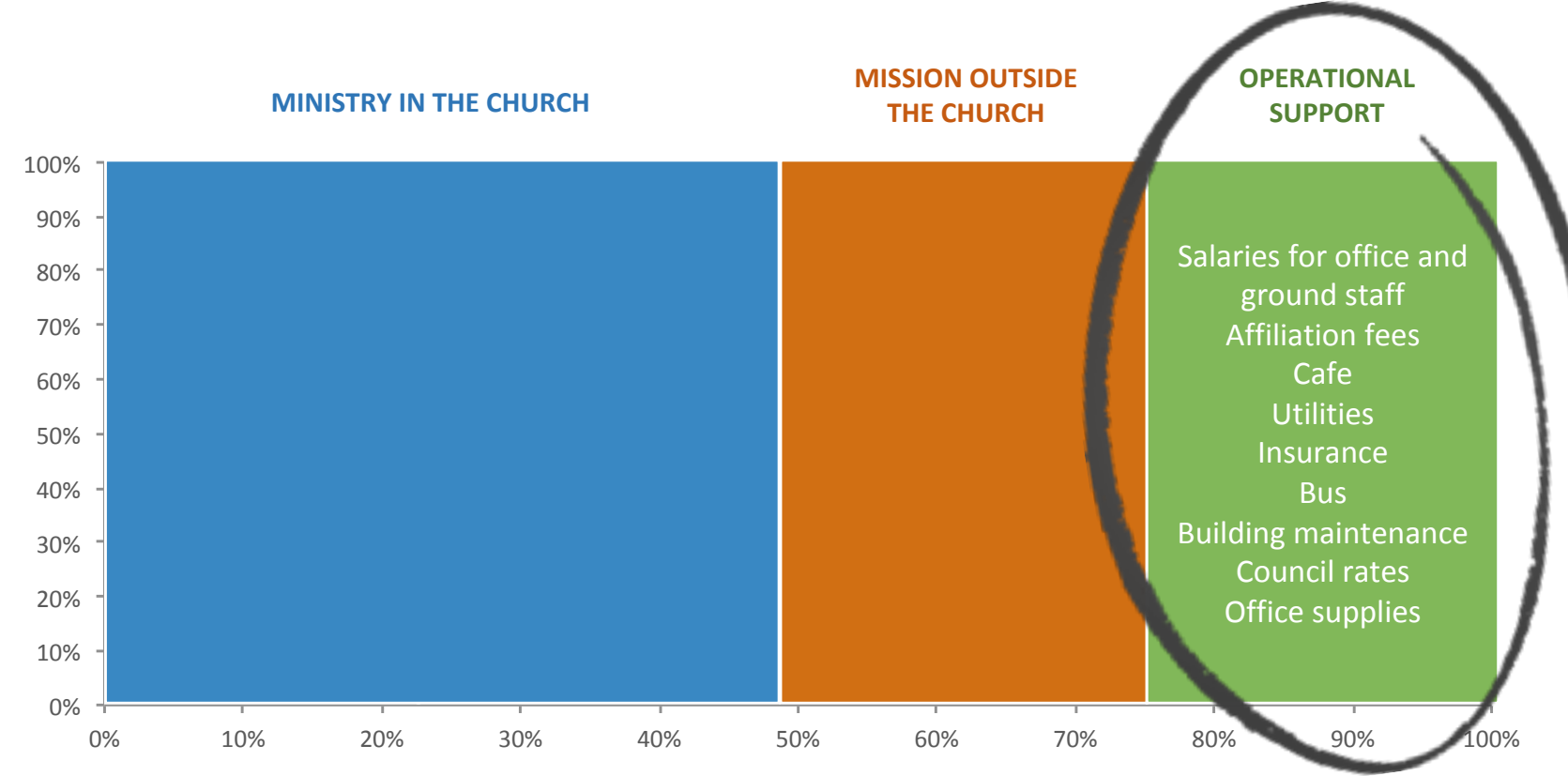
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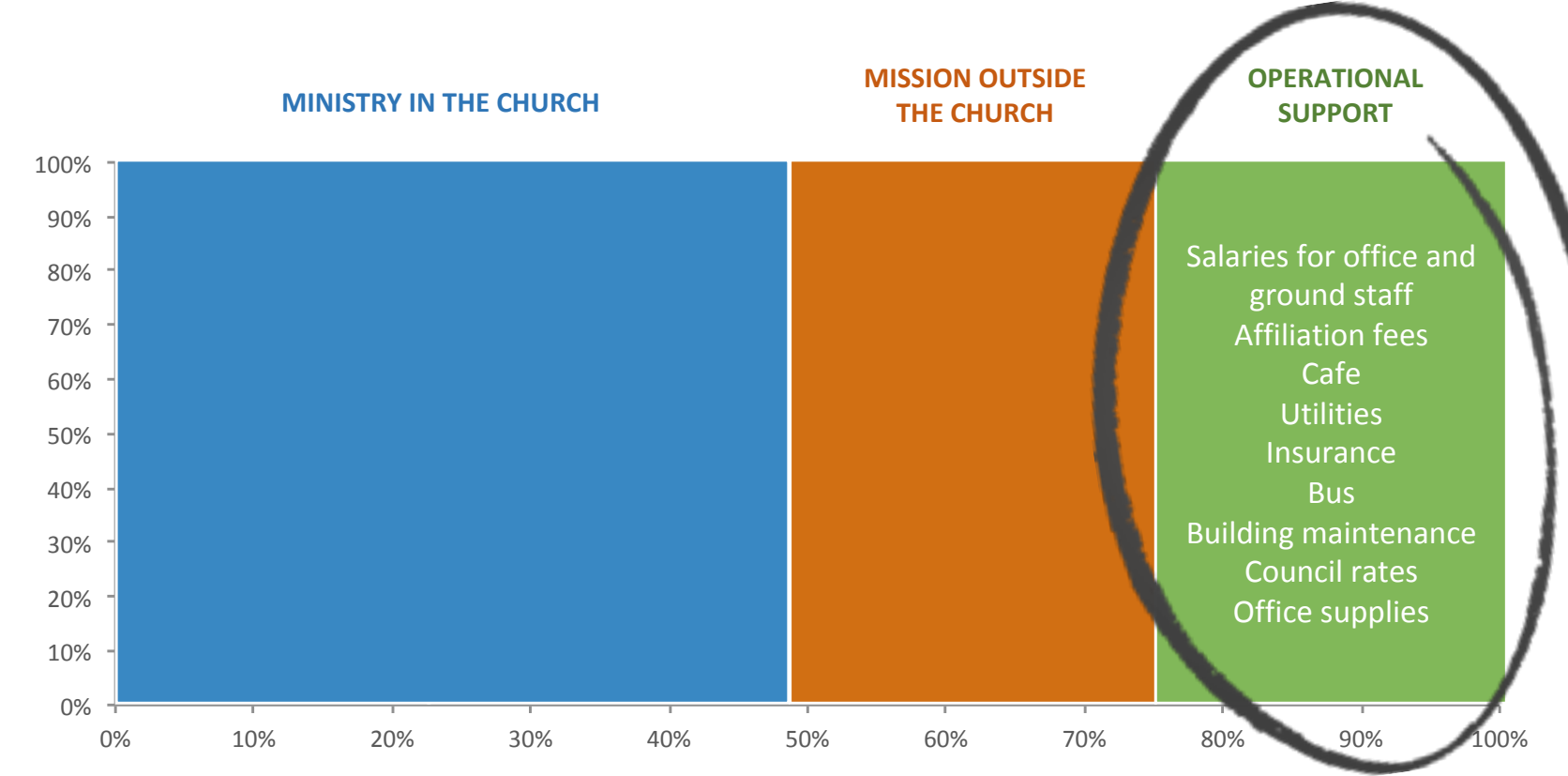
A quarter of our spending enables the church to run smoothly in support of our ministry and mission.



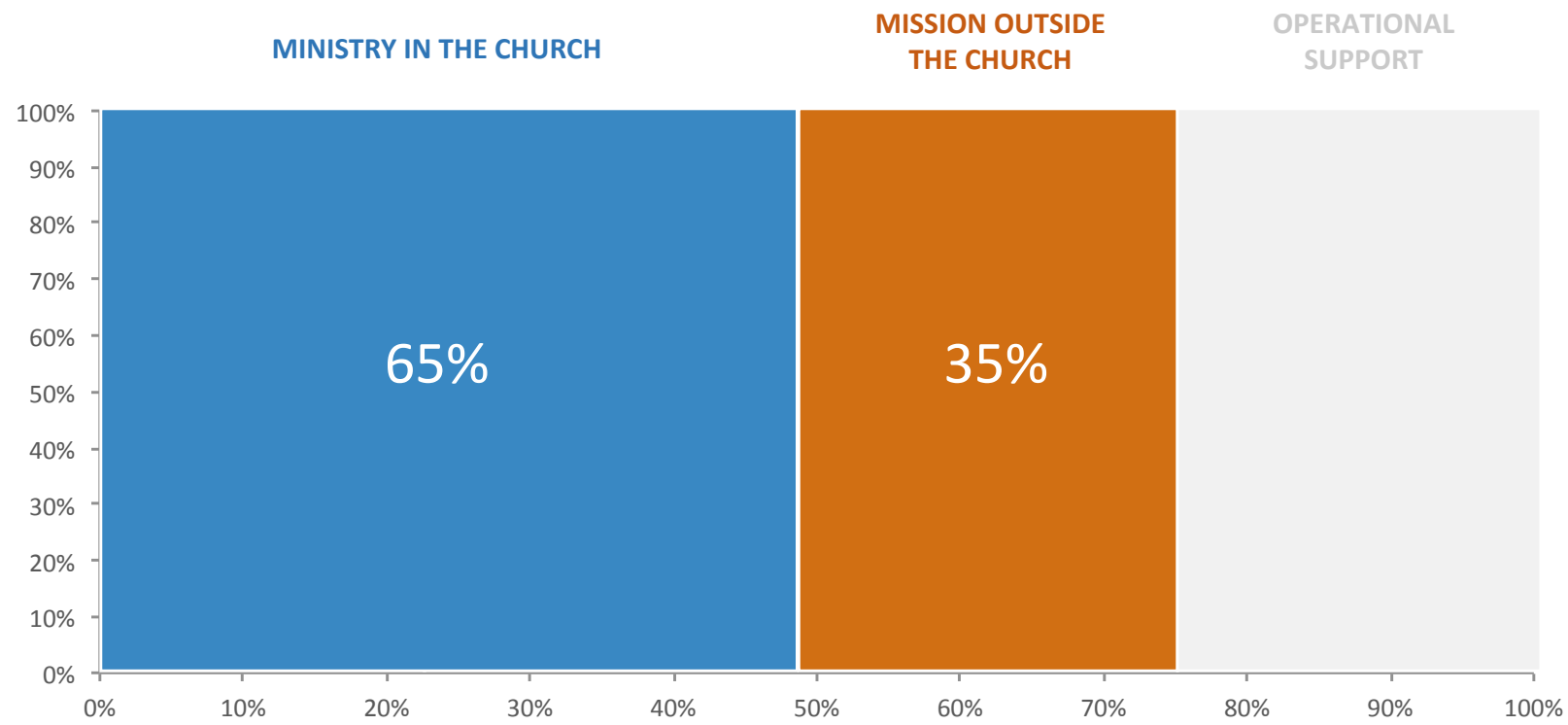
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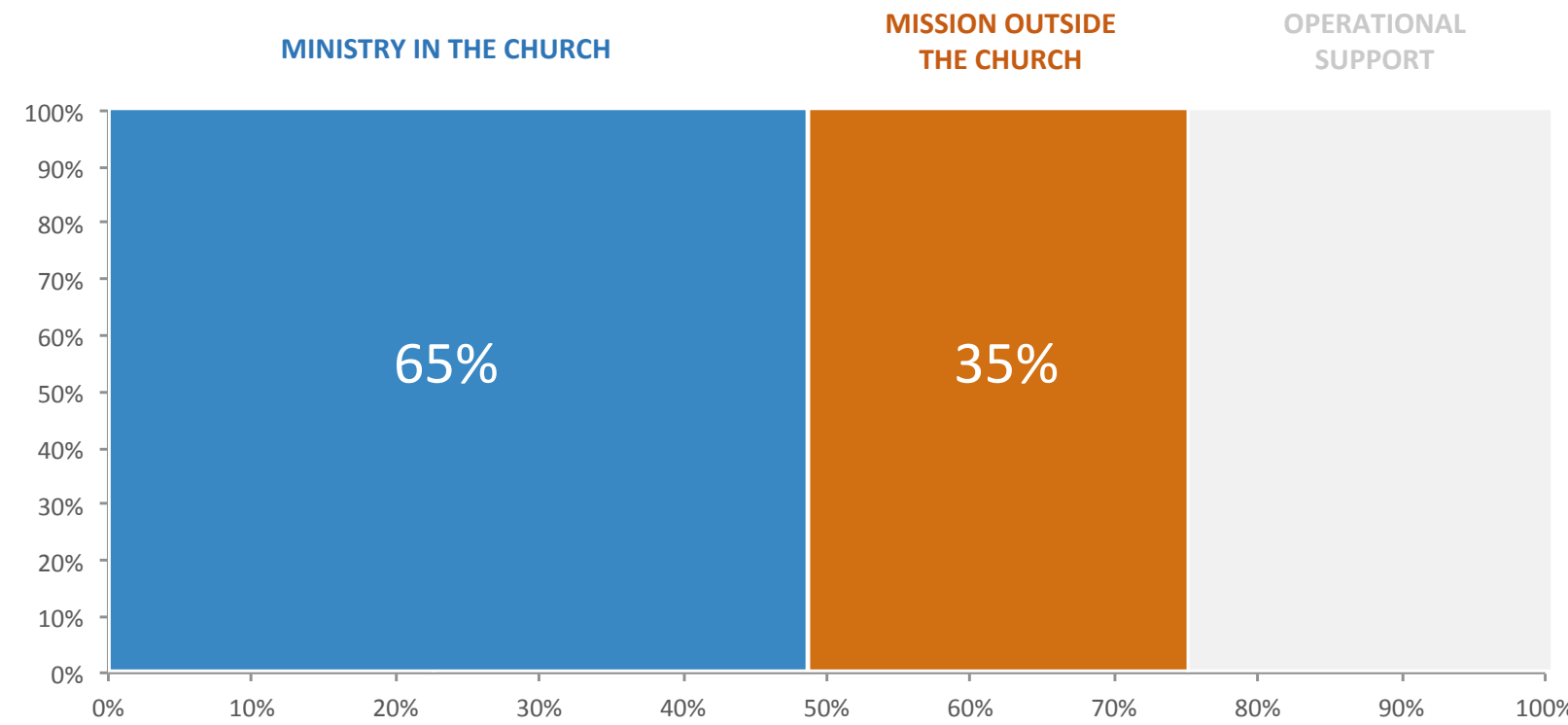
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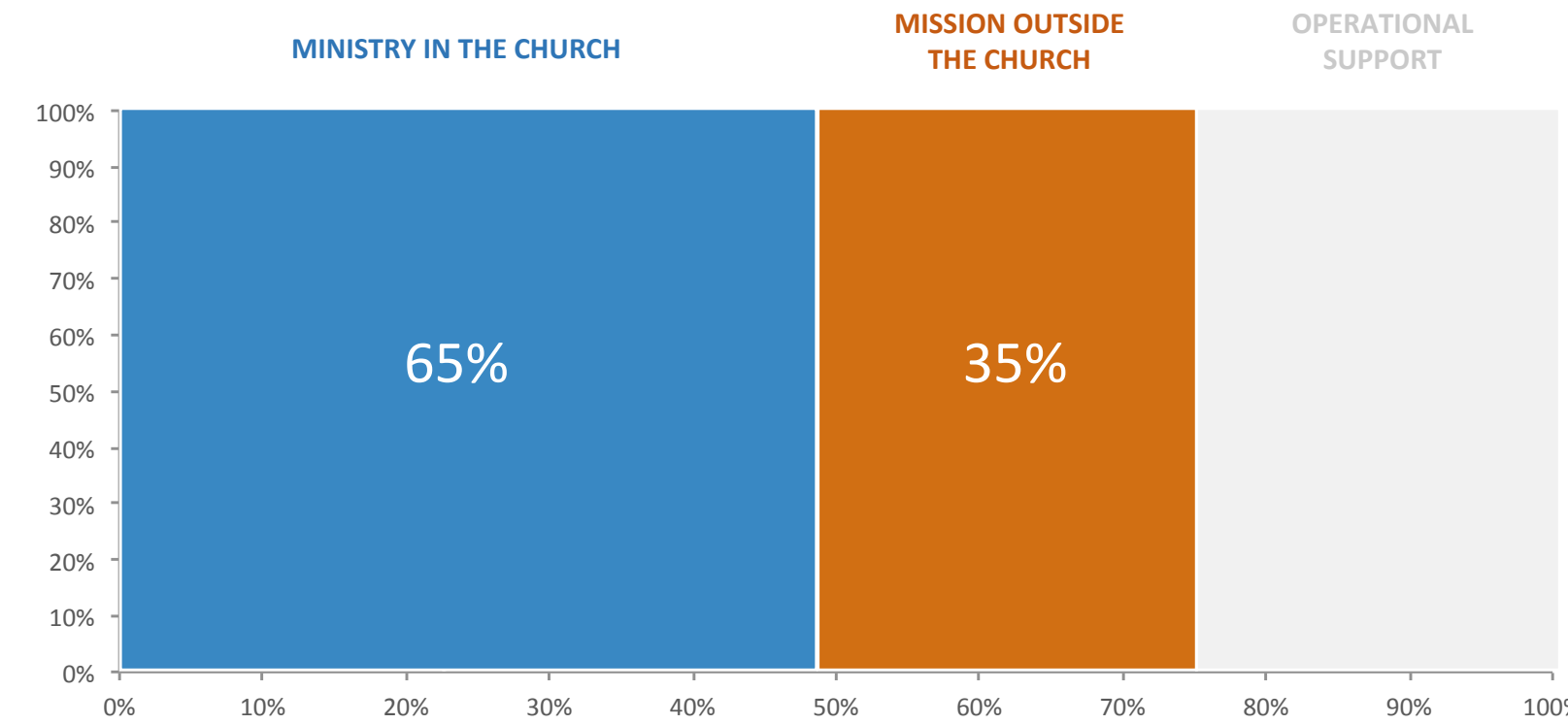
Of the funds available for church ministry, we spend about two-thirds within the church and a third in mission outside our walls.



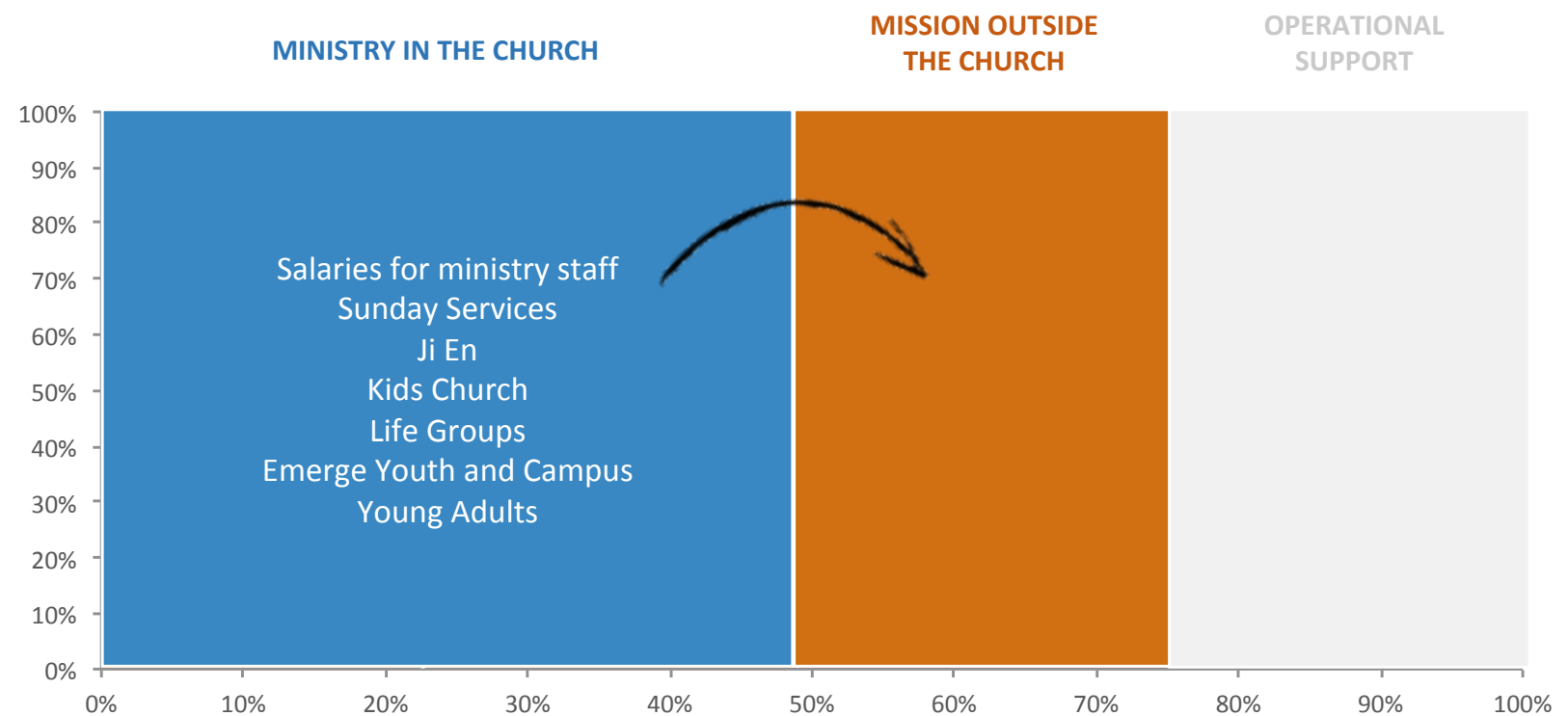
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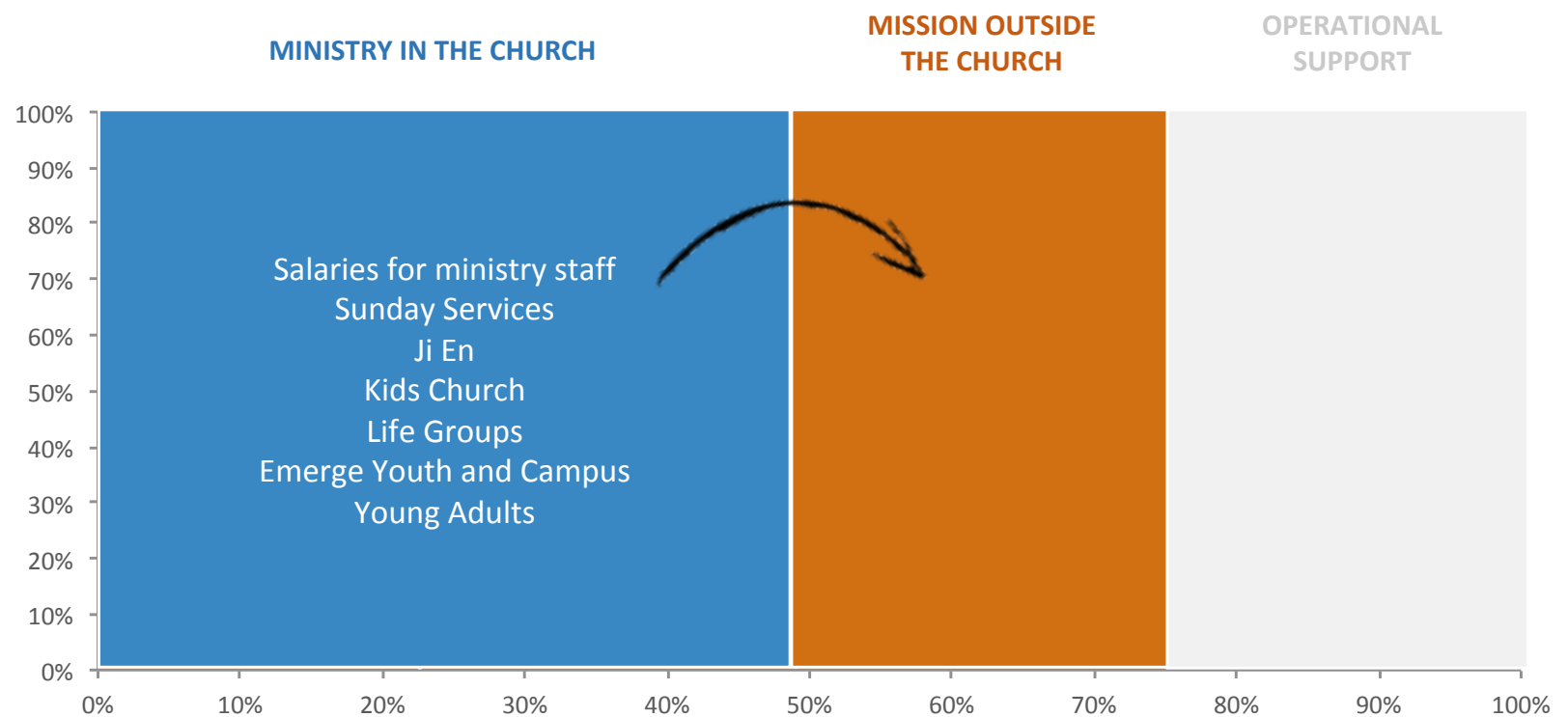
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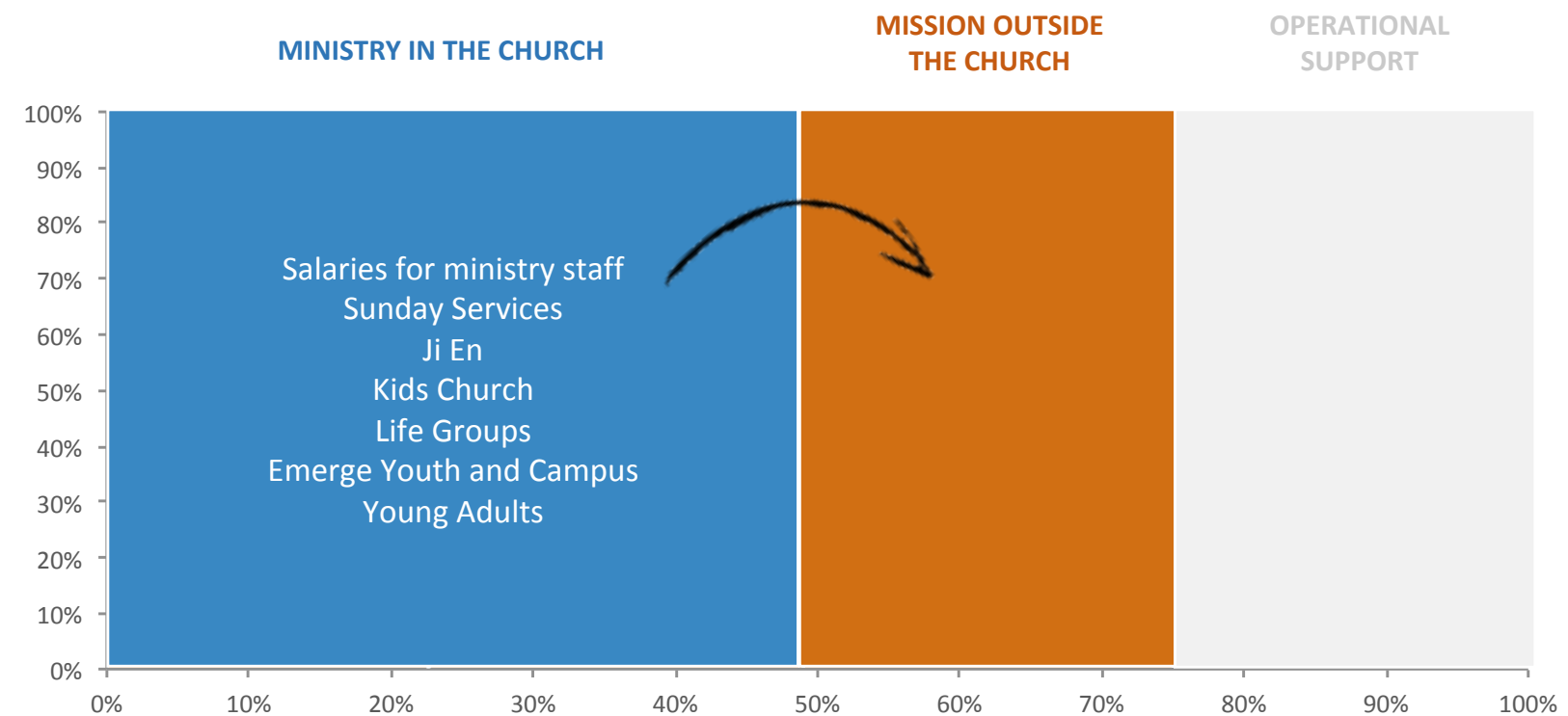
We invest in our people to build disciples who will represent Jesus outside the walls of this church.



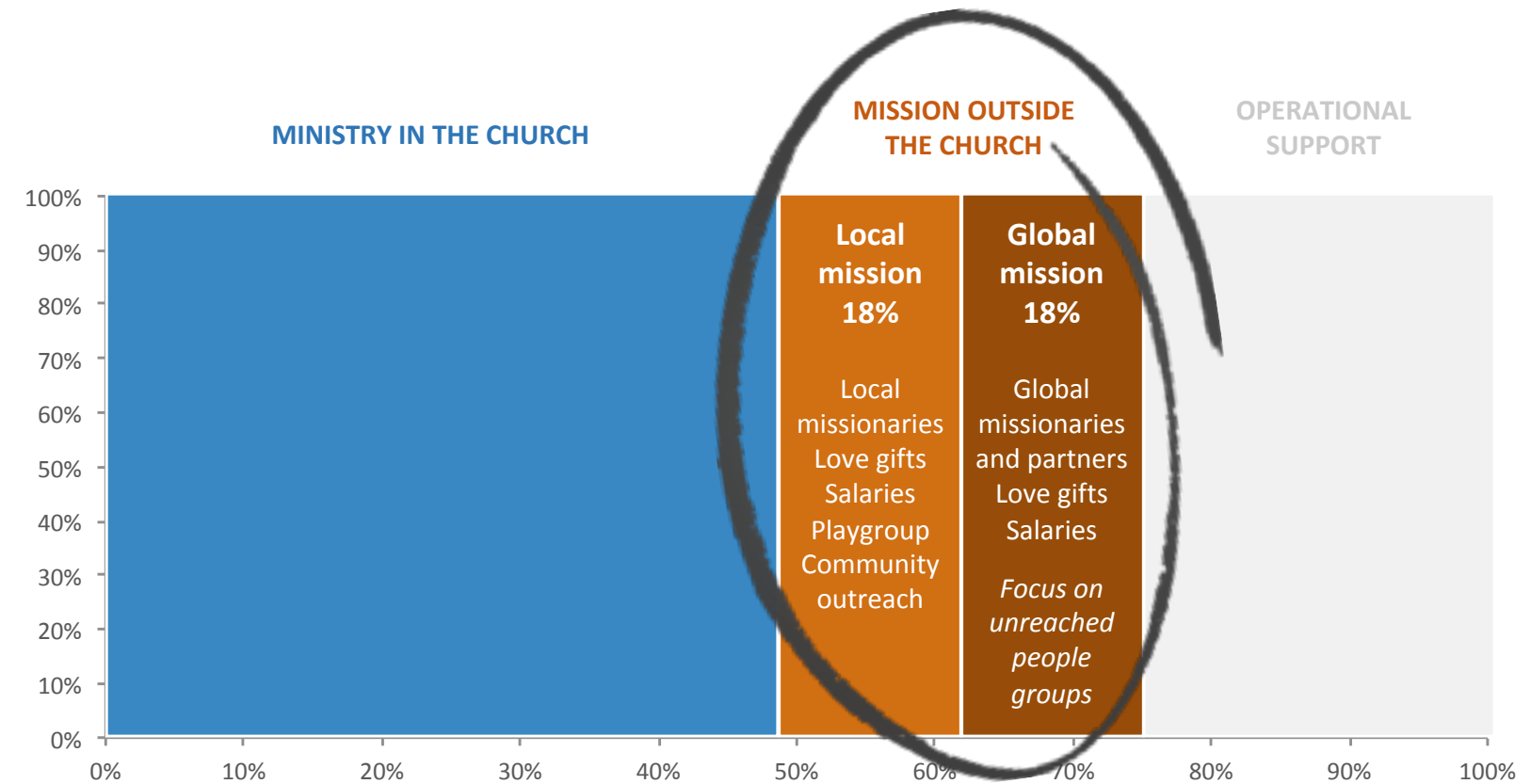
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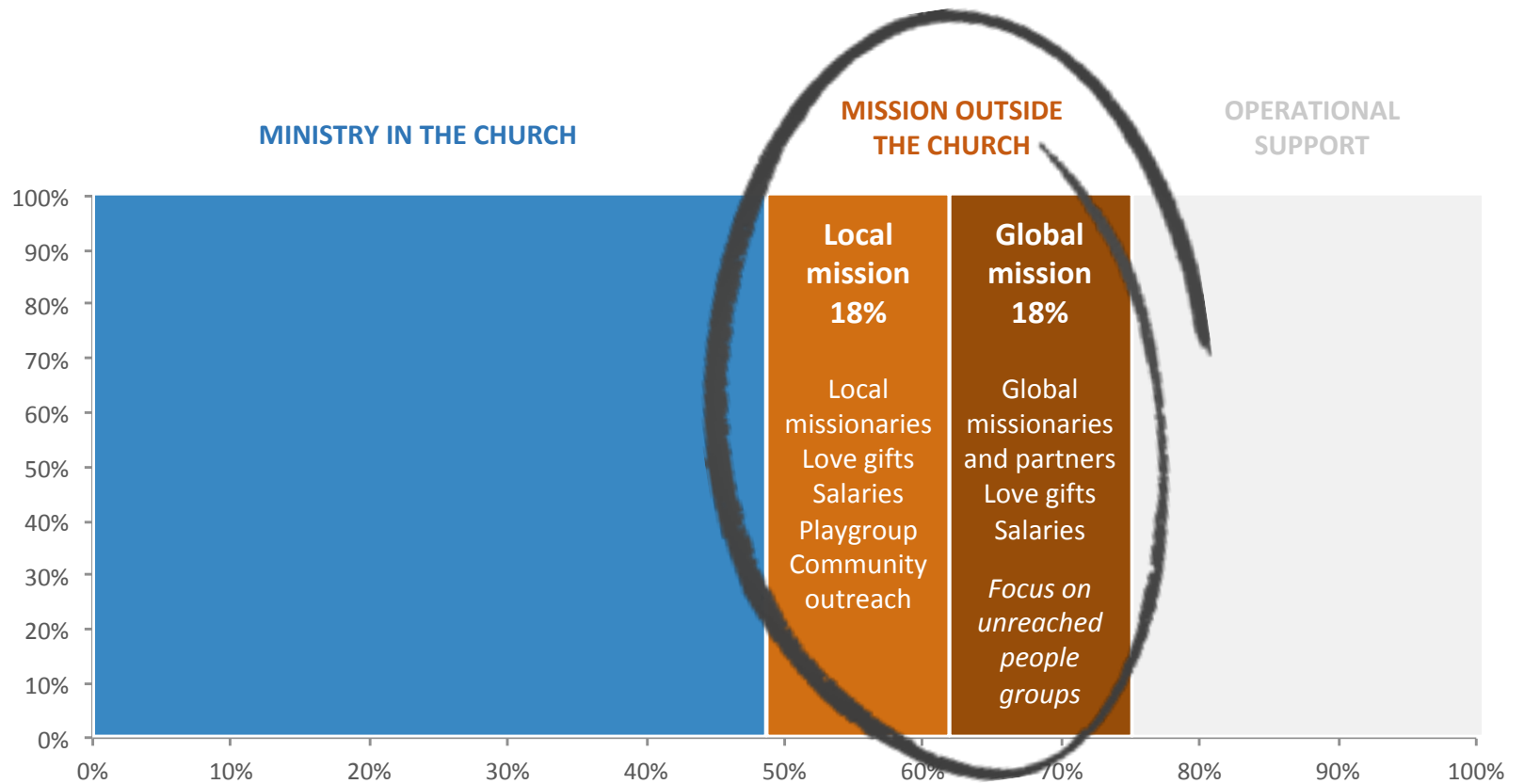
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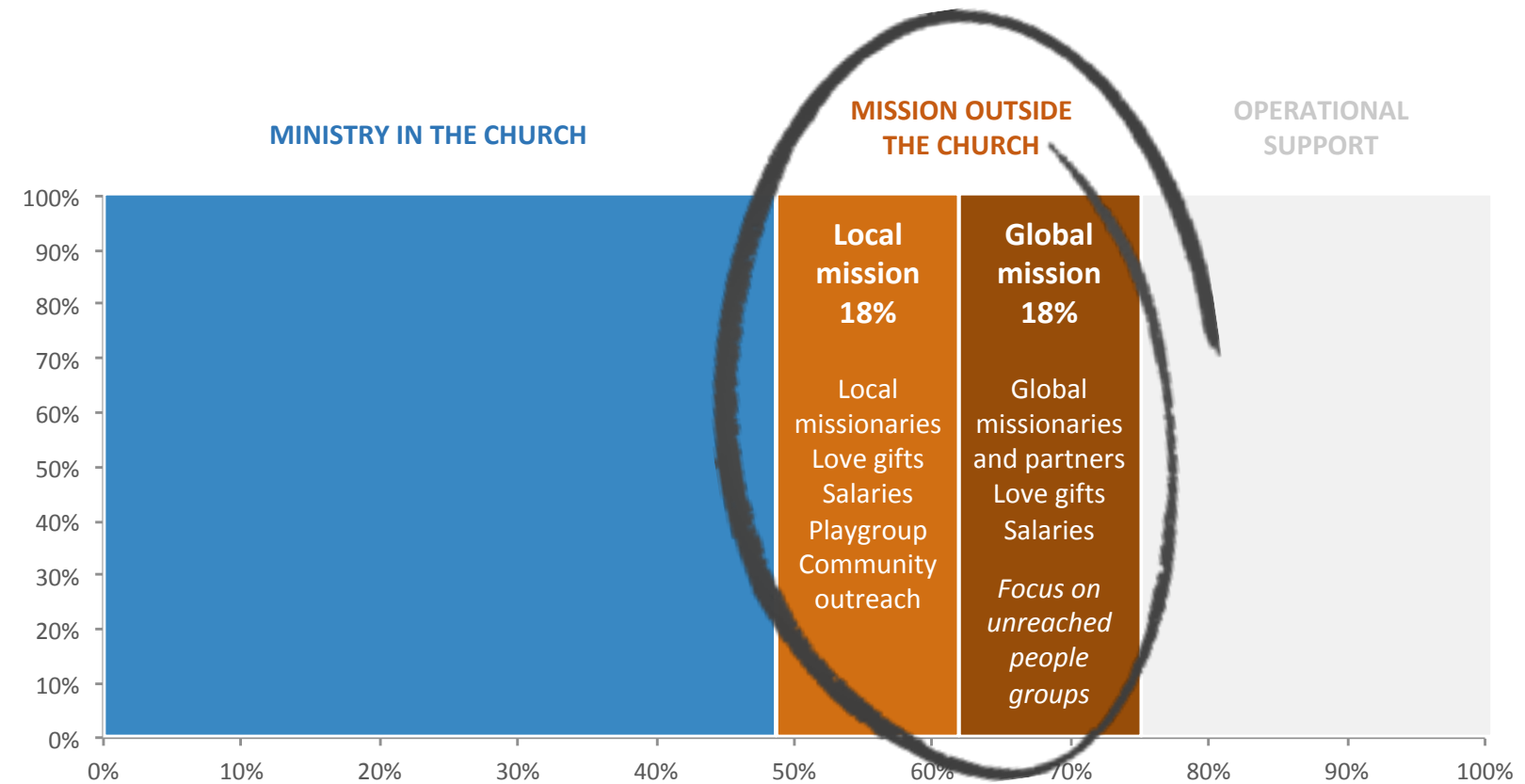
Our mission spending is split evenly between local and global.



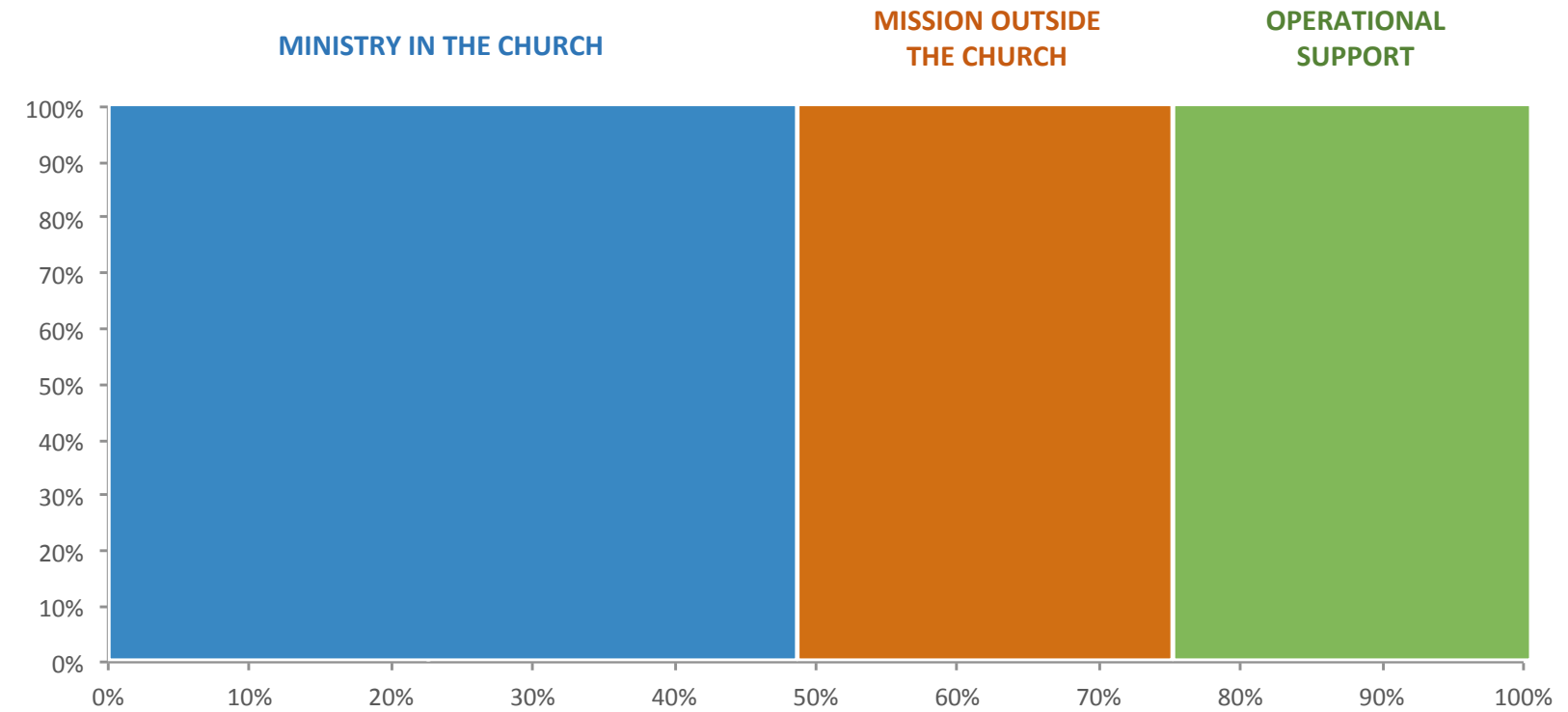
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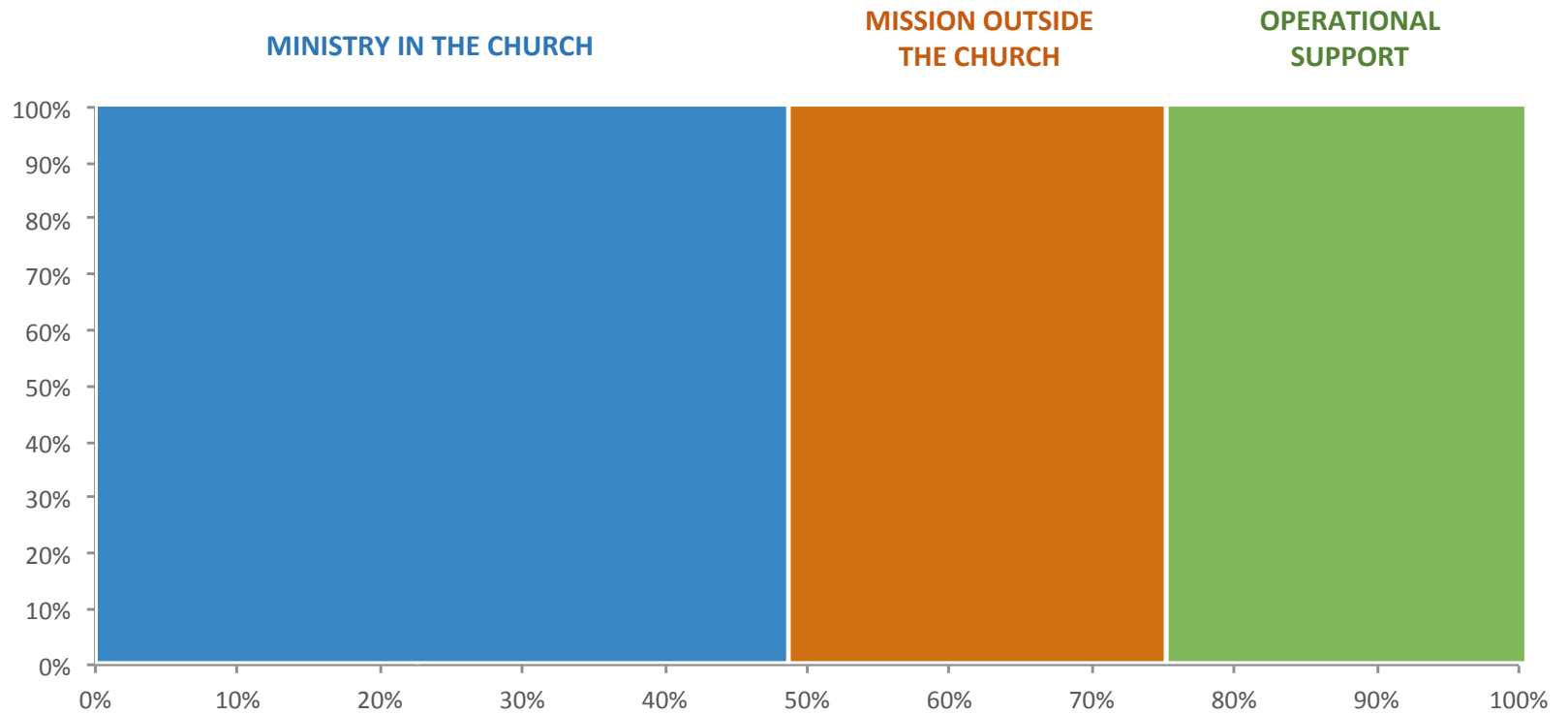
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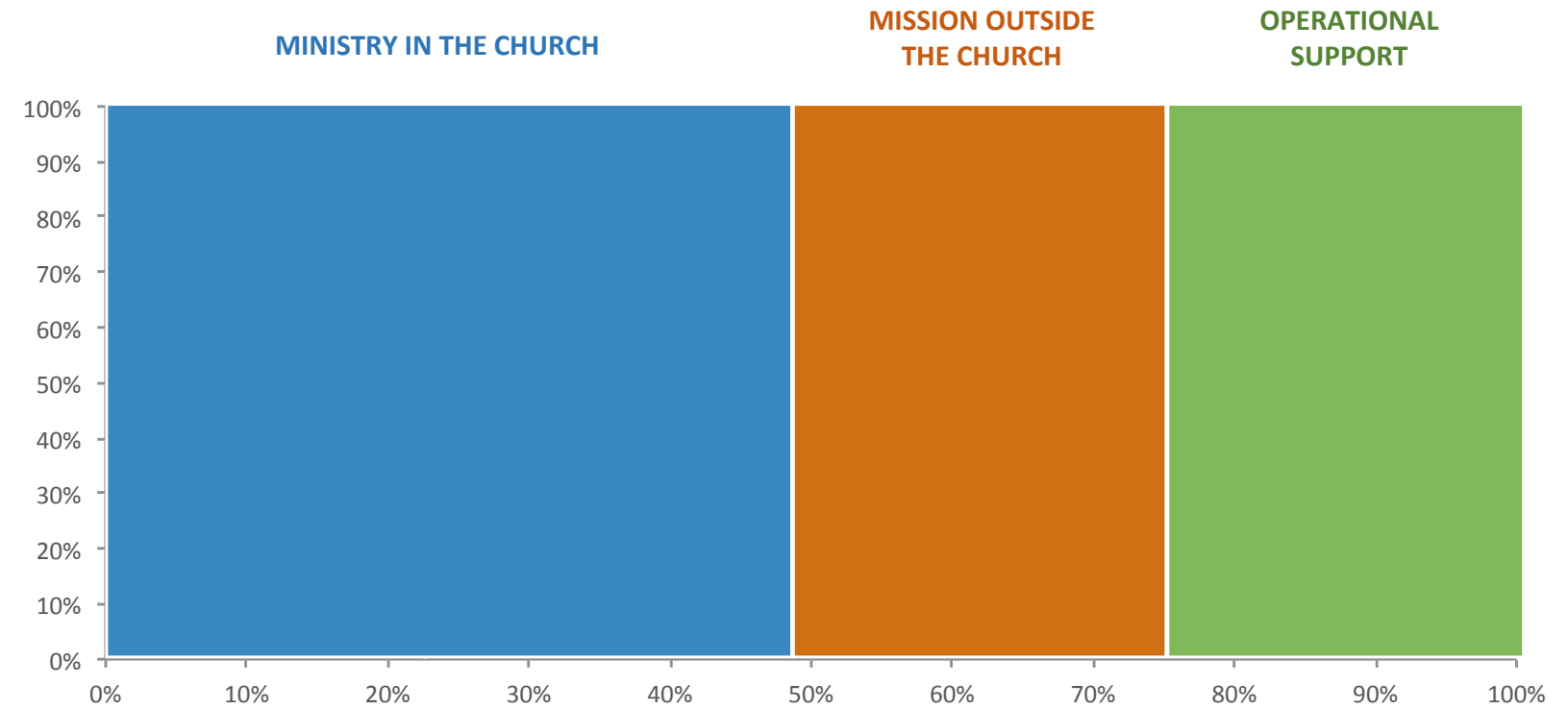

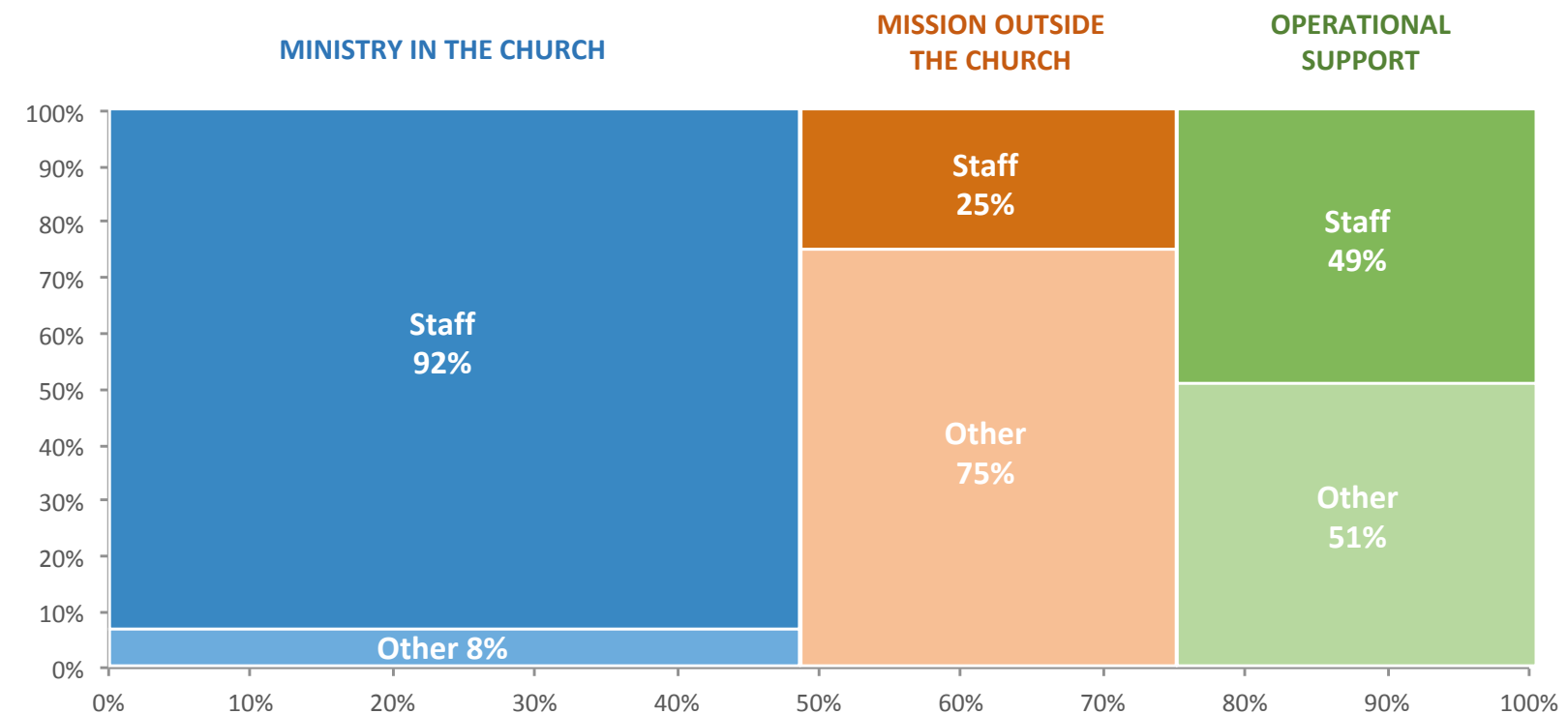
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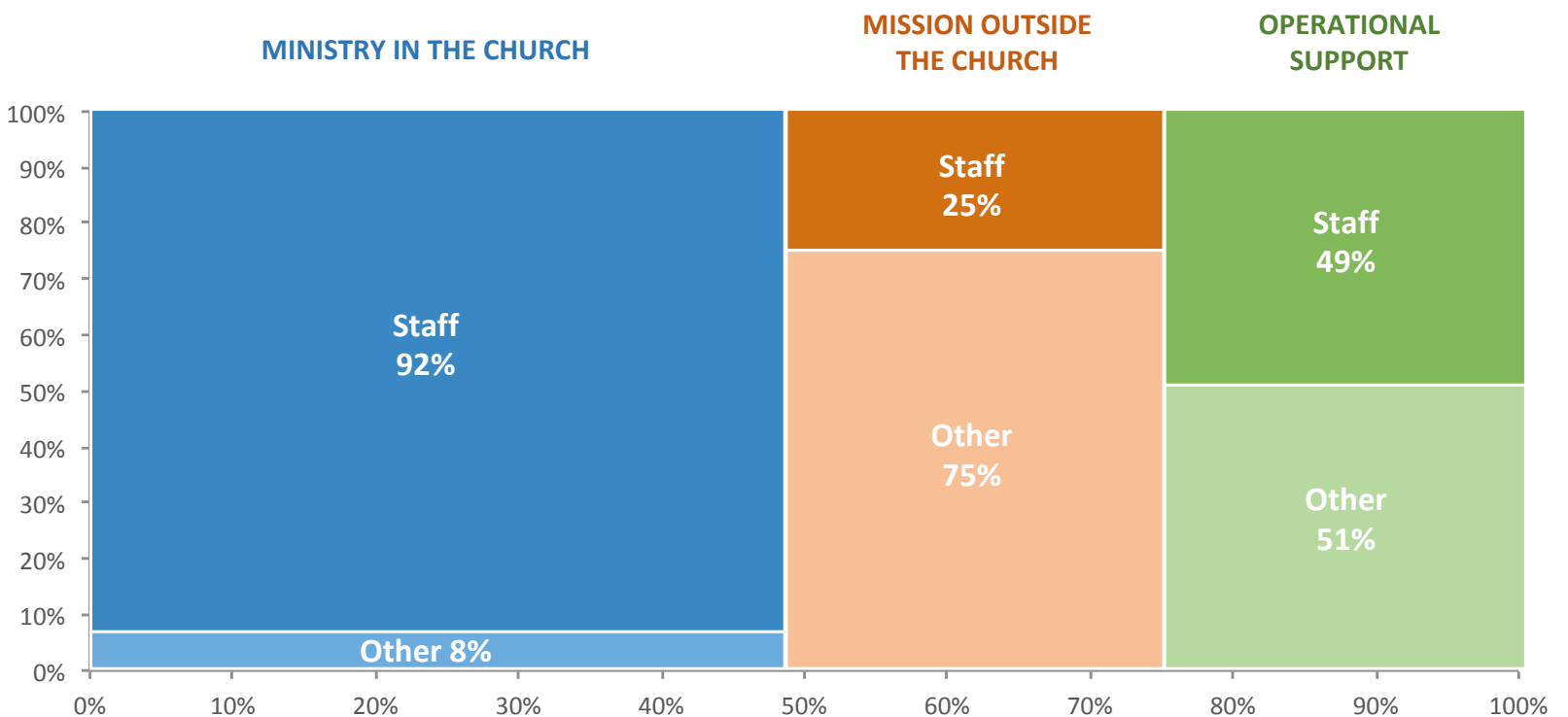
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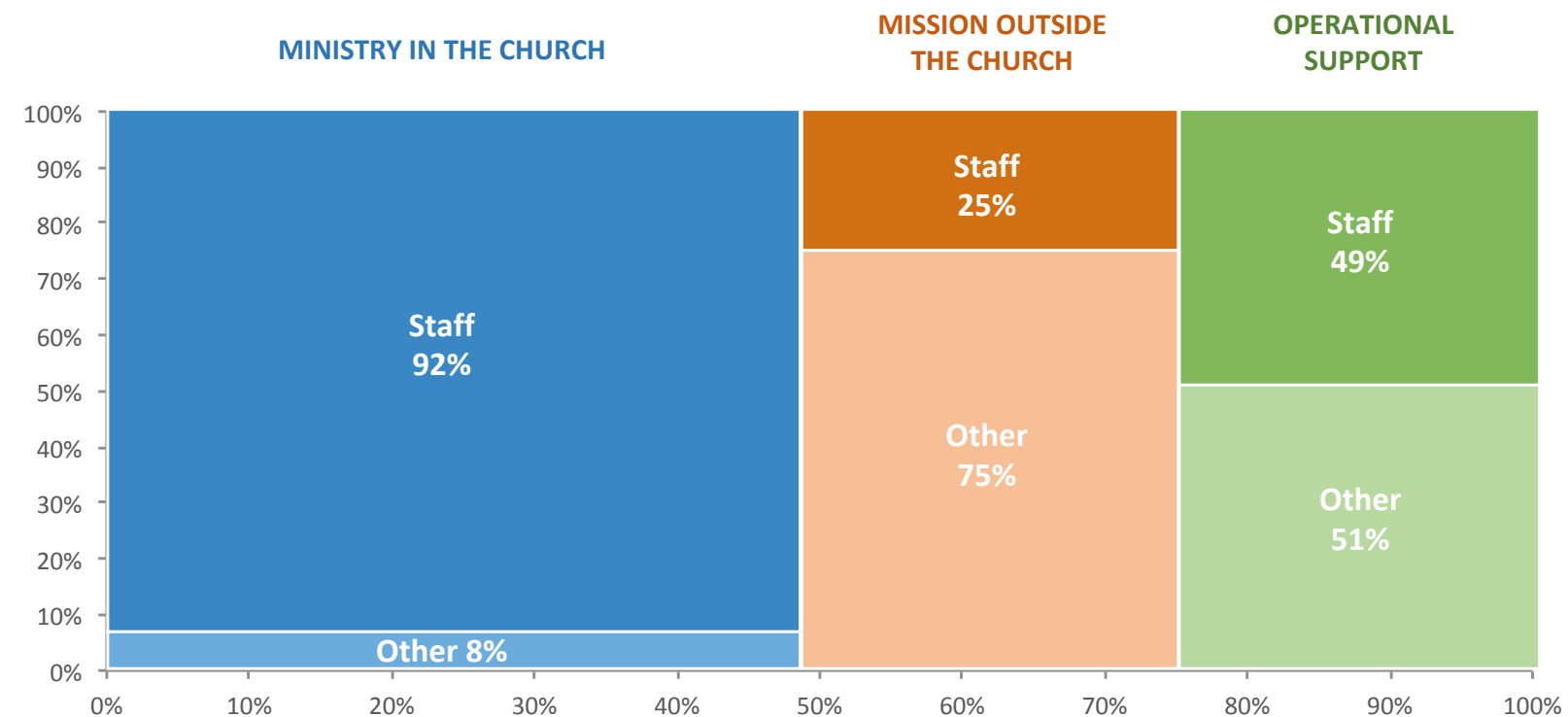
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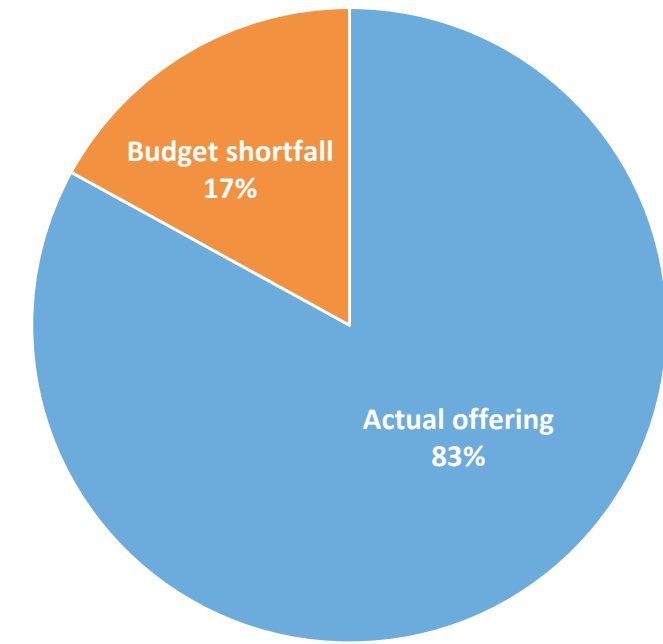
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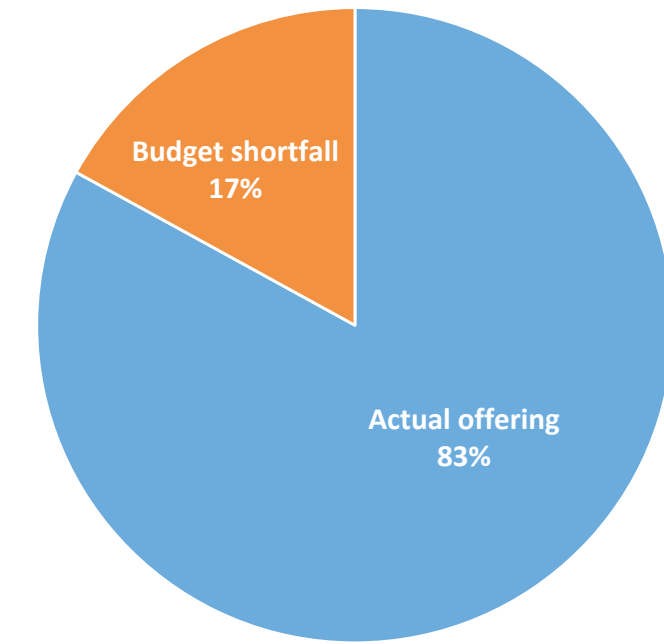
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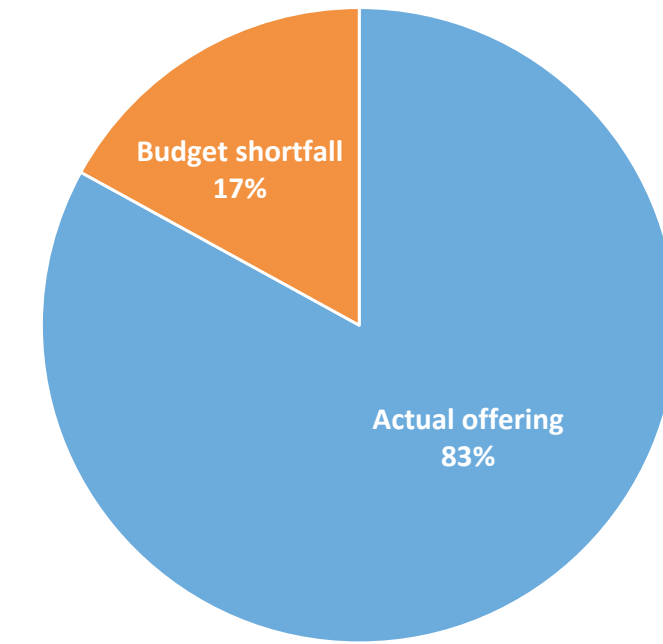
Actual offering as a percentage of budget (YTD, 7 months to April 2018)



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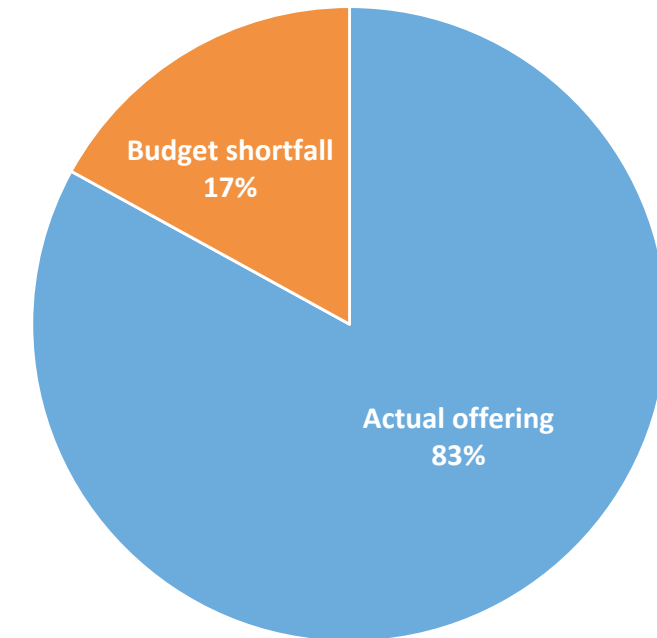


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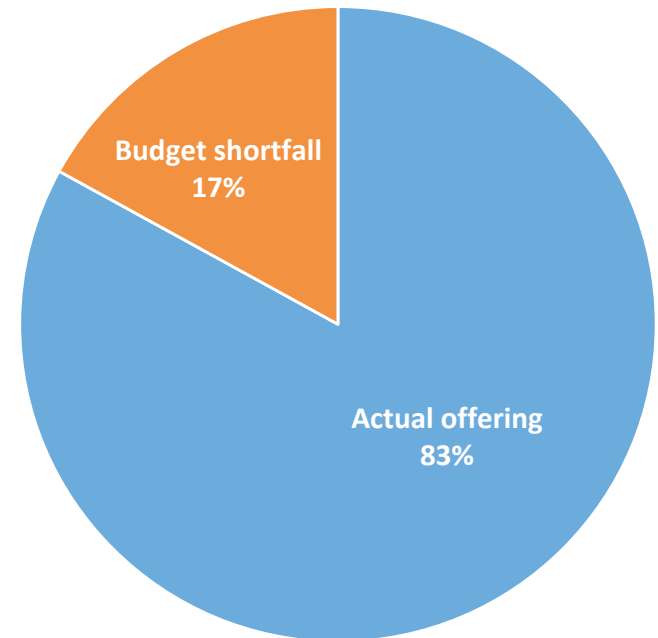

1 Meanwhile, Six days before the Passover celebration began, Jesus arrived in Bethany, the home of Lazarus—the man he had raised from the dead. **2** A dinner was prepared in Jesus’ honor. Martha served, and Lazarus was among those who ate with him. **3** Then Mary took a twelve-ounce jar of expensive perfume made from essence of nard, and she anointed Jesus’ feet with it, wiping his feet with her hair. The house was filled with the fragrance. **4** But Judas Iscariot, the disciple who would soon betray him, said, **5** “That perfume was worth a year’s wages. It should have been sold and the money given to the poor.” **6** Not that he cared for the poor—he was a thief, and since he was in charge of the disciples’ money, he often stole some for himself. **7** Jesus replied, “Leave her alone. She did this in preparation for my burial. **8** You will always have the poor among you, but you will not always have me.”



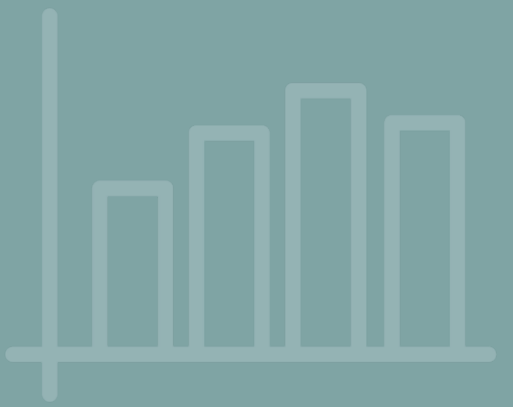

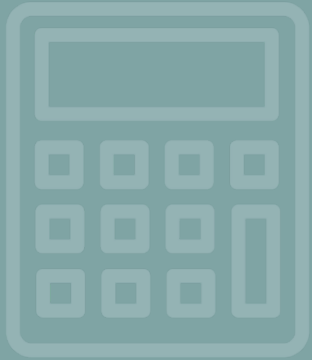

While he was eating, a woman came in with a beautiful alabaster jar of expensive perfume made from essence of nard. She broke open the jar and poured the perfume over his head. **4** Some of those at the table were indignant. “Why waste such expensive perfume?” they asked. **5** “It could have been sold for a year’s wages and the money given to the poor!” So they scolded her harshly. **6** But Jesus replied, “Leave her alone. Why criticize her for doing such a good thing to me? **7** You will always have the poor among you, and you can help them whenever you want to. But you will not always have me. **8** She has done what she could and has anointed my body for burial ahead of time. **9** I tell you the truth, wherever the Good News is preached throughout the world, this woman’s deed will be remembered and discussed.” **10** Then Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve disciples, went to the leading priests to arrange to betray Jesus to them. **11** They were delighted when they heard why he had come, and they promised to give him money. So he began looking for an opportunity to betray Jesus.
